

Mamoni Raisom Goswami

14th November 1942 – 29th November 2011

Indira Goswami, known by her pen name Mamoni Raisom Goswami and popularly as Mamoni Bakdeo, was an Assamese editor, poet, professor, scholar and writer.



A celebrated writer of contemporary Indian literature, many of her works have been translated into English from her native Assamese. These include *The Moth Eaten Howdah of the Tusker*, *Pages Stained With Blood* and *The Man from Chinnamasta*. Her work has also been recreated on stage and celluloid. The film *Adajya*, based on her novel won many international awards.

She is also known for her attempts to structure social change, both through her writings and as mediator between the armed militant group United Liberation Front of Assam and the Government of India. This led to the formation of a peace committee named People's Consultative Group.

Although, she suffered from depression since her childhood and repeated suicide attempts marred her youth, Mamoni Goswami is an example of how a person can beat insurmountable odds by overcoming their past and go onto become a legend.
